Govt. College Seraj at Lambathach has constituted a road safety club to undertake a campaign towards reducing road injuries by changing mind sets of public towards safe driving and traffic rules. The club is functioning under the chairmanship of Dr. Rakesh Sharma, Principal Govt. College Seraj and Professor Vivek Kapoor is the convener, other staff members and students are its members.

Activities of Road Safety Club

1. Independence Day Celebration

Road Safety Club of Govt. College Seraj At Lambathach celebrated the Independence Day of our nation in a peaceful and grand manner. Dr. Rakesh Sharma, Principal of Govt. College Seraj At Lambathach hoisted the National Flag and accepted the salute and guard of honour. On this occasion, under the supervision of Principal, students of the college, faculty members and nonteaching staff took oath on Sadak Suraksha.









2. Declamation Contest on Road Safety

Road safety Club of Govt. College Seraj at Lambathach organised a Declamation Contest to generate awareness among students to follow traffic rules on dated 10.11.2022. Around six students of the "Road Safety Club" participated in the contest. Usha and Pekshita won the first prize. Diksha and pallavi won the second and third prize, respectively.









3. Slogan writing, poster Making and painting competition

Road Safety Club organised a slogan writing, poster Making and painting competition on the theme of ROAD SAFETY on dated 17 November, 2022. The students Participated with immense zeal and enthusiasm, to create awareness and alert young generation's outlook of Road Safety and thereby saving lives by minimizing road accidents. 5. Road Safety Awareness session

A session on road safety awareness was organised by road Safety club, in association with NSS, NCC and Rovers & Rangers unit of Govt. College Seraj At Lambathach on 29th November, 2022 which was presided over by Principal, prof. Jaya Thakur. The first speaker that was given the floor was Inspector Sh. Munish Kumar. He spoke about maintain certain rules and regulations while using social media, like not disclosing financial and social status and while making friends with anyone on social media. He also specified that morphing others photographs, sending malicious emails or mocking someone on social media are punishable crimes and the police can actually trace the people who create fake ID's and indulge in such crimes. The second speaker Constable Sh Raj Kumar spoke about traffic rules and regulations. He said, "Awareness on the road is very important for your safety and safety of others". He discussed the statistics of various types of road accidents in the state and explained the resons that lead to these accidents. He further gave examples of various types of traffic violations and the penalties associated with them. The session ended with Q & A's and brief discussion among speakers and students.

6. Quiz Programme
