



Energy conservation/ Use of solar energy

- The Institution conducts awareness programmes on energy conservation and adopts measures to ensure that energy is conserved wherever possible.
- All the departments follow a policy of switching on power only when required and switching off when not in use.
- Class rooms in Institution have very wide and long windows with a high roof of almost 12ft which ensures that the use of lights and fans would be minimum as ventilation is naturally enhanced.
- Many classrooms, departments, administrative office and the Principal Chamber of the college are airy and well illuminated for the maximum use of natural lighting during the day time. Tube lights and inverter Bulbs are used instead of incandescent bulbs wherever the natural lighting is Insufficient to minimize power consumption. The institution strictly observes to see that no electric equipments run unnecessarily. Thus, enough measures are taken to use electricity carefully.
