NCC Day 25. 11. 2023

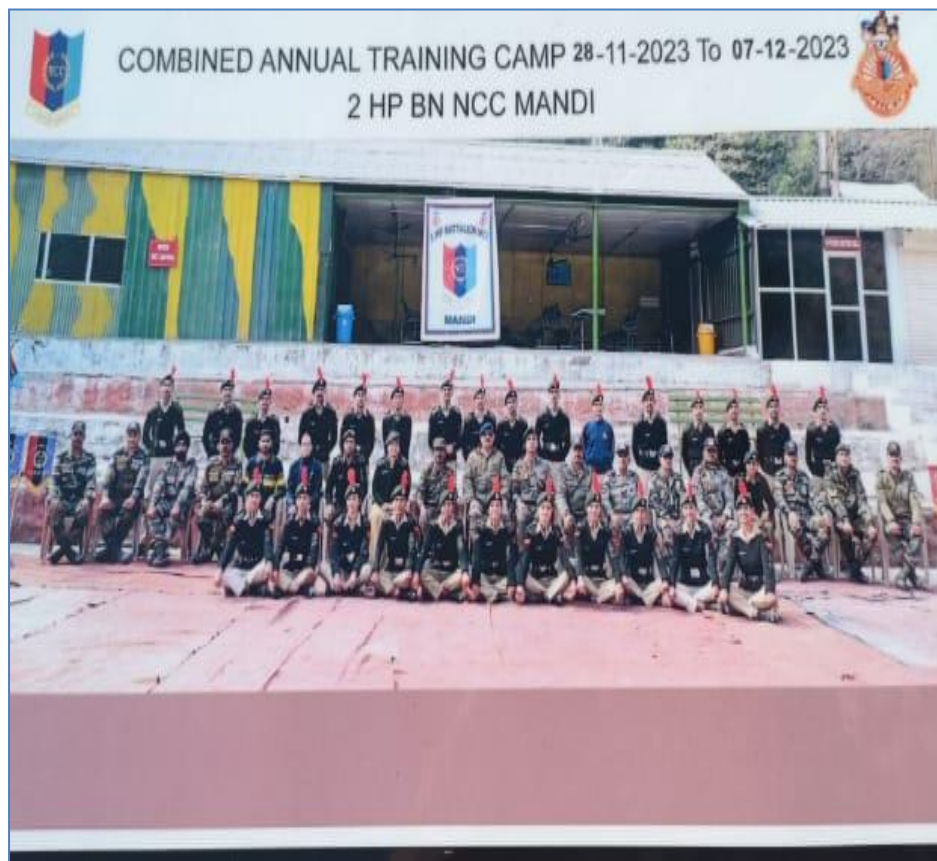

Celebrations of 75th Republic day (26 January 2024).

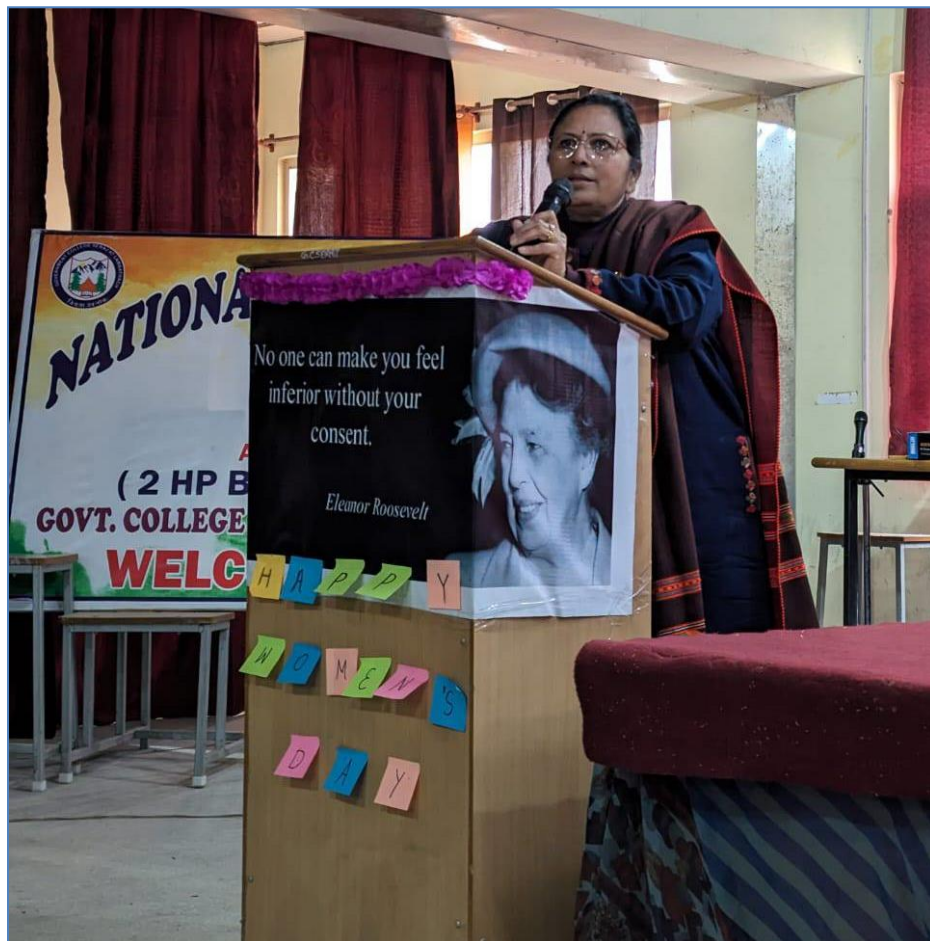
