#### **1.1.3. Flipped Classroom**

At Government College Seraj at Lambathach, the concept of the flipped classroom is being gradually introduced as an innovative teaching–learning practice. Under this approach, students are encouraged to study core content before class through materials such as PDF notes, e-content, video lectures, and reference links shared by faculty members via Google Classroom, WhatsApp groups, and email.

During the classroom sessions, instead of traditional lectures, teachers engage students in discussion, problem-solving, group presentations, and doubt-clearing activities. This allows students to apply their pre-acquired knowledge, participate actively, and develop critical thinking and analytical skills.

The flipped classroom method shifts the focus from teacher-centered instruction to student-centered learning, fostering greater participation and self-responsibility among learners. Faculty members in various departments make use of ICT tools, multimedia presentations, and online resources to support this method effectively.

Although the practice is in its developing stage due to infrastructural and connectivity limitations in the rural setting, efforts are being made to expand and institutionalize flipped classroom activities across departments in the coming academic sessions.
