Inter-Class Economics Quiz Competition – 2024

On September 28, 2024, the Department of Economics organized a competitive Quiz Competition to evaluate students' grasp of economic concepts, foster critical thinking, and encourage teamwork. The event provided a platform for students to engage deeply with the subject matter outside the traditional classroom environment.

The competition saw enthusiastic participation from students across all Economics classes. To honour the legacy of the discipline, the five participating teams were named after legendary economic thinkers. Each team consisted of **four representatives** from various classes: **Team J.B. Say, Team Karl Marx, Team Amartya Sen, Team Keynes** and **Team Adam Smith**. The quiz was structured into **five rigorous rounds**, covering a broad spectrum of the economic landscape:

- **The Budgetary Round:** Union and State Budgets.
- **Planning Round:** Five-Year Plans of India.
- **Macro-Indicators Round:** Sectoral contribution to GDP.
- **Nobel Laureates Round:** History of Nobel Prize winners in Economics.
- **Evolutionary Round:** History of Economic Thought.

The competition was closely contested, with all teams demonstrating impressive analytical skills. Following the final tabulation, **Team Keynes** emerged as the victors, securing the **First Rank**. Winners were awarded academic essentials, including **notebooks and pens**.

To promote inclusivity and celebrate the effort of all attendees, **chocolates** were distributed to every student in the department. The event concluded with a summary by **Assistant Professor Amita**, who commended the students for their preparation. The program successfully met its objectives of enhancing subject knowledge while building a strong sense of community within the Department of Economics.

On 25th November 2024, the Department of English hosted a landmark event titled "**Initiating A Dialogue: English Edition.**" This marks the first time such an initiative has been organized on campus. The event was unique in its execution, being **entirely student-led**, with the primary goal of fostering a spirit of learning, expression, and communication in the English language. The core philosophy behind the event was to empower students to find a "voice" that extends beyond their regional boundaries, allowing them to engage with the world at large.

The event was graced by the presence of **Principal Dr. Vikram Singh Thakur** as the Chief Guest. **Mr. Chander Mani**, President of the PTA, also attended as a Special Guest, lending his support to the student-led initiative. In his keynote address, the Principal delivered a very motivating speech. He shared the classic story of **King Bruce and the Spider**, using it as a metaphor for the **power of perseverance**. He emphasized that mastering a language requires consistent effort and resilience.

The event featured a **diverse range of activities** designed to test both the creative and analytical skills of the participants:

- **Poetry & Song Interpretation**
- **The Debate:** A spirited debate was held on the topic: "**Is Urbanism the way forward?**" Students argued the nuances of modern development versus sustainable living.
- **Skill-Based Competitions:** To sharpen technical linguistic skills, the event included:
 - **Spelling Bee:** Testing vocabulary and phonetic accuracy.
 - **Grammatical Error Detection (GED):** Challenging students to identify and correct complex linguistic structures.

With 259 students in attendance and 55 participants across activities, the event successfully sparked a new enthusiasm for English communication, proving that language is the ultimate bridge to the world beyond regional spaces.
